

Architectural Office van Döllen Oldenburg



The architectural office van Döllen realizes projects for private, commercial, and public clients, with a focus on northern and central Germany. Its construction projects include residential and administrative buildings, schools, workshops, nursing homes, kindergartens, and sports facilities. In 2001, the second generation, architect Rita van Döllen-Mokros, took over the management of the office. Additionally, the range of services includes expert consulting. The architectural office van Döllen is part of a network that also offers property development, real estate, and property management services. In mid-2024, van Döllen moved into its new building on Kreyenstraße in Oldenburg. The building comprises approximately 3,200 square meters of rental space, with two full floors used by the company itself. These floors are connected by a staircase equipped with the high-quality Allura staircase system from k-stairs. Thanks to its exceptional durability, slip resistance, and flexible production options, the system is ideally suited for this high-traffic area. The adjacent hallways were also fitted with Allura design flooring in the same décor, creating a seamless transition between the staircase and the surrounding floor areas. Allura offers a wide range of colors, and the selected wood-look design blends perfectly into the overall interior concept. Combined with the wall cladding, the staircase area appears warm and inviting.

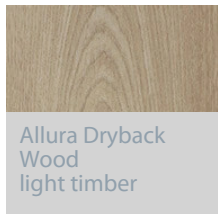
