

Atuarfik Inussuk, Nuuks nye skole



Nuuk's new school, Atuarfik Inussuk, is designed as both a learning environment and a meeting point for the city. The school functions as a landmark where the child stands in the center, and where buildings and outdoor areas together create a living "village". The architecture draws inspiration from Greenland's natural history and has a strong focus on the indoor climate, daylight and beautiful rooms that promote well-being and community. At the same time, the school combines durability, acoustics, comfort and visual identity in a holistic floor design. KHR Architects, led by project leader Morten Nøhr Frandsen, worked with Marmoleum in the colors Barbados, Silver Shadow and Rose 3263 to support activity, orientation and the children's energy. Marmoleum Decibel reduces footfall noise by up to 18 dB and creates a calm learning environment. The result was so impressive that King Frederik X expressed his appreciation during his visit in 2024.
