An inspiring pavilion with Marmoleum and Tessera Bureau Kroner Architects is known for its well-thought-out designs that combine functionality and experience. For its own pavilion, the focus was on an interior that is bright, sustainable and inspiring. The choice of flooring plays a central role in this. The communal areas feature Marmoleum Walton in the colour Petrol. This flooring is sleek, contemporary and made from natural raw materials.
