

Cygnus Gymnasium Amsterdam - Pays-Bas



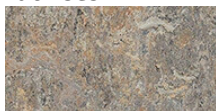

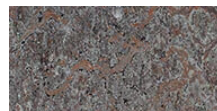

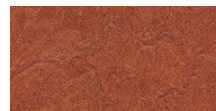
