

Greenhill Centre, ACT



The Greenhill Centre is a conference and group camping centre for the Uniting Church established in 1965 and located in Canberra. The site is situated on the Murrumbidgee River. Long-term durability, ease of maintenance and superior resistance to spills and stains were key factors in the selection of Flotex planks flooring for their dining hall area which can facilitate up to 200 people.
