"The new office design consisted of various working, meeting, break out and kitchen zones, which were all connected, yet distinguished through the specification of different floor coverings of various materials and shades. For the main working and office space we chose Forbo's new homogeneous vinyl, Sphera Element in the Fog colourway, because of its durable properties and its clean, non-directional aesthetics, which provided a seamless appearance. Tessera Inline carpet tiles in the Onyx shade were interspersed throughout, to create a path around the space to aid wayfinding. As this has a directional aesthetic, we had it installed in the direction in which the employees are intended to walk, dictating the route."
