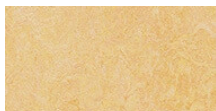

Indeed, we chose to use this material throughout the building, with the exception of the exterior and the wet rooms (clean rooms, changing rooms, kitchen, etc.). Its inherent advantages make it a particularly suitable material for child-friendly facilities (flexible floor, easy maintenance, etc.). In addition this material enabled us to achieve the ambitious environmental objectives of this operation: the Mediterranean Sustainable Building label, silver level, and a pilot building for the new E+C- regulation, having reached E3C1 level."

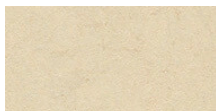

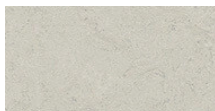

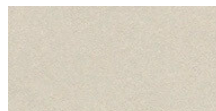
