





The robust qualities and unique geometrical design of Forbo Flooring Systems' Flotex Triad planks has helped to refresh the entrance level of this busy university library in Glasgow. The Andersonian Library, located in the Curran building at the University of Strathclyde, is a public facility for thousands of students and staff across Glasgow's universities. What's more, as it's a busy library, it was important for us that the flooring was also easy to clean, as the floors are very prone to food and drink spillages."
