The ARGE Großkemm I Richard + Monse I Molnar, from Solingen had an uncommon construction to plan: a stationary care facility for 20 handicaped adults, aged 18 to 55 years. The ARGE erected a building for three living groups, each of it provides enough space for four or eight people. The project was named "House of Life" and was erected next to the Protestant aged care facility Cronenberger Street.
