Therefore she designed "Interface", a tray coming in a variation of colors and appealing patterns which can be used in a café like setting to serve drinks, but also to write or draw on it. Because Desktop linoleum can be cleaned easily, people can use a crayon to share little stories with each other or scribble what they have on their mind. Thanks to this tray and the materials she used, Lisha hopes to provide a warmer experience for people, making them pay more attention to their surroundings and for a moment take a step out of the virtual world.
