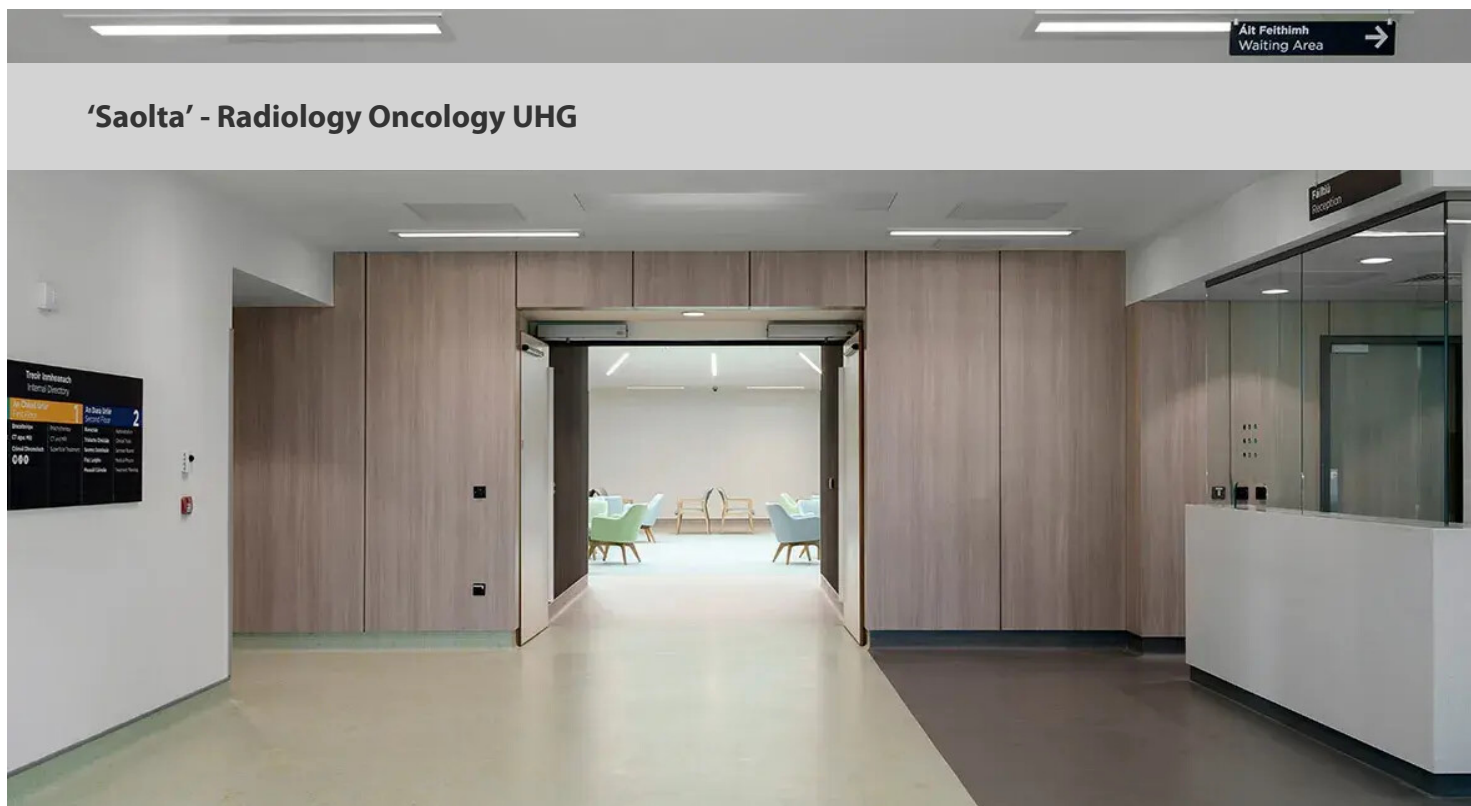
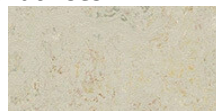
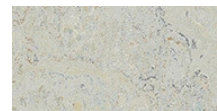
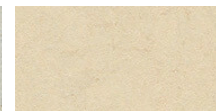
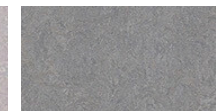
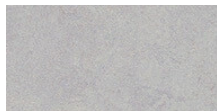
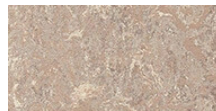
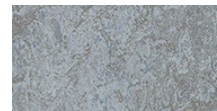
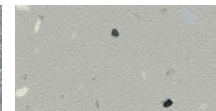
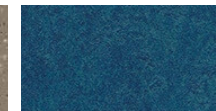


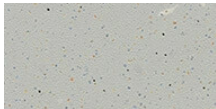


The new building of "Saolta Radiology Oncology UHG" includes six radiotherapy treatment bunkers, a brachytherapy suite, CT & MRI diagnostics and on-treatment-support consultancy. The challenge with all clinically demanding buildings is keeping the patient's experience at the heart of the design without sacrifice to medical functionality. The patient's journey, mindset and vulnerabilities were given weight in all decisions. The final layout revolves around two central atria that flood key patient areas with light, link floors and inform wayfinding. Forbo floorings durability, functionality, colour and design pallet provided the ideal solution to all these requirements.
