Attributes of Flotex:

- Durable 46,000 upright nylon 6,6 fibers per inch², resists crushing and matting
- Easy to Clean Our dense, upright fiber makes it easier to clean (no loops or twists to trap dirt)
- Soil & Stain Resistant Most spills can be removed, including permanent marker
- Slip Resistant Wet & Dry Provides safety and minimizes liability from slips and falls

Cleaning

- Dual motor upright vacuum with a rotating brush
- Spot clean when necessary using Scrape,
 Scrub, and Rinse or spotter machine
 As needed, use water or general purpose
- As needed, use water or general purpose spot cleaner or hydrogen peroxide cleaner on spot

Maintenance

- Vacuum then Scrape, Scrub and Rinse if necessary
- Use a self-contained portable extraction machine with counter-rotating brushes
- Rotary scrubbing machine with a flagged bristle brush for restoration cleaning
