1.3 Product Description:

Forbo Ready to Use Residential Floor Finish is a finish designed for easy application. It will help to protect the floor from traffic and soil. It is 'ready to use' directly out of the bottle.

2. APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS

Forbo Ready to Use Residential Floor Finish should be used directly from the bottle, undiluted. Remove all dry, loose surface soil by sweeping, vacuuming or dust mopping the floor. Mix 1/2 – 1 ounce of Forbo Neutral pH Cleaner with 1 gallon of clean, unheated tap water. Apply the solution to the floor using a mop or clean cloth. Do NOT flood the floor. If the solution becomes dirty, mix a new solution to prevent spreading the dirt across the floor. As an alternative, Forbo offers a pre-mixed Ready to Use Neutral pH Cleaner can be sprayed onto the floor – no dilution required.

If necessary, use a non-abrasive scrubbing sponge to remove stubborn or ingrained dirt from the floor. Use a clean cloth or mop to remove the soil and cleaner from the floor. Rinse the cloth or mop frequently. Wipe or damp mop the floor with clean, unheated tap water. Dry the floor with a clean, dry mop or towel. Keep foot traffic and pets off the floor so it remains clean.

Work in small areas. It's suggested to do a 3' x 3' area at a time. Apply a small amount of the Forbo's Residential Floor Finish onto the floor. Use a clean, dampened mop, sponge or finish applicator to spread a thin coat of the finish on the floor. Spread the finish as even as possible and try to avoid leaving puddles of the finish. This can cause the finish to dry unevenly and look streaky.

NOTE: It is only recommended to use Forbo's Residential Floor Finish on Marmoleum. Any other finishes used can be difficult to remove or repair from Marmoleum and may even damage the floor. If any other finishes are applied to Marmoleum, it may require a professional floor care company to remove it.

Continue working in small areas until the entire floor has been covered. Allow 10 – 15 minutes for the floor to dry. Keep foot traffic and pets off the floor during this process. Repeat these steps for a shinier appearance on the floor. Do NOT apply more than 2 – 3 coats of finish to the floor at one time.

VERY IMPORTANT!! Once Forbo's Residential Floor Finish has been applied to the floor, it must be removed before repeating the restoration process.
