SUSTAINABLE

Marmoleum sequesters more CO₂ emissions than are caused by raw material production and transportation and manufacturing processes, thanks to its renewable plant-based raw materials, we maximize the recycled content by including both pre-industrial as well as post-consumer recycled content. At the end of its life, it can be recycled and transformed into new flooring, again and again.

In Marmoleum Cocoa we aim to maximize the % of recycled content. We combine material recovered from installation waste and uplifted floors with internally recycled production waste. Additional recycled inputs, such as wood flour and cocoa shells from other industries, further contribute to its circular composition. As a result, Marmoleum Cocoa contains 38% recycled content, 14% of that is recycled pre-and/or post-consumer flooring waste. The balance between the pre- and post-consumer waste varies, due to availability of installation waste and old floors through our Back to the Floor program.

The right mix between pre- and post-consumer material is needed to guarantee flooring product quality. The quality of post-consumer material is very challenging. To guarantee high quality flooring our recycled content is fully tested against health and safety norms, before we reuse it in our new floors.

FAIR

The uniqueness of Marmoleum Cocoa extends far beyond the floor itself. Through its recent partnership with Kumasi, Forbo Flooring sources cocoa shells in a way that directly benefits cocoa farming communities.

In traditional chocolate production, only the cocoa beans are used, while up to 75% of the fruit is typically discarded. What was once considered waste is now transformed into a valuable resource, providing farmers with additional income from materials that would otherwise go unused.

At the heart of this story is our collaboration with Dutch-founded social enterprise Kumasi Commodity Innovations, transforming an innovative flooring concept into a powerful example of how beauty, sustainability, and purpose come together.

Kumasi's impact goes even further: they also utilize the juice from the cocoa fruit, another overlooked part of the harvest, to create beverages, unlocking even more value for farmers while reducing waste throughout the supply chain. By sourcing cocoa fruit juice directly from farmers in countries such as Ghana, Ivory Coast, and Ecuador, Kumasi enables farmers to earn additional income from the delicious fruit that was previously discarded.

An important element of this collaboration is its commitment to women's empowerment. Through programs connected to the cocoa value chain, Kumasi creates opportunities for women in cocoa-producing regions to build financial independence and strengthen their communities. This commitment is embedded in the partnership: supplying cocoa shells to Forbo Flooring Systems goes hand in hand with supporting these social initiatives.



MAKING NEW MARMOLEUM from a 20-year-old floor

Currently, circularity has not yet been achieved on a large scale in the building industry for flooring. Solutions are challenging when the flooring is glued to the subfloor, which is the case for most of the resilient flooring in use today.

Pioneering with circular Marmoleum

In 2021, a project was initiated with the Technical University of Delft in The Netherlands to take back 13,000 m² of old Marmoleum which had been installed in the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Mathematics and Computer Science (EEMCS) for over 20 years. The challenge was to fully recycle these floors into brand new Marmoleum, a task which was quite uncommon. This first project laid the foundation for scaling up our take-back approach, demonstrating that installed Marmoleum can be successfully recycled and paving the way for further take-back volumes.

RECYCLING IN STEPS

Renovation is usually a matter of demolition and reconstruction, but the project for TU Delft required a more delicate approach. Both the subfloor and the floor covering needed to remain as intact as possible and contamination of the material had to be avoided. With a floor stripper, the Marmoleum was removed quickly and meticulously.

FROM FLAKES TO POWDER

Once removed from the building, the floor was sorted to remove undesired residual waste and was then scrapped and ground. About one third could be recycled in new linoleum, the rest was used for other industries.

FROM UNIVERSITY TO HEINEKEN

The Heineken Experience, the brewery museum, approached us for a circular solution for their new floors. In the end the floor from the University in Delft ended up in a new floor for the famous brewery in Amsterdam.

PRODUCT DEVELOPMENT & DESIGN

- Marmoleum Cocoa is designed to go round, it contains recycled content from end-of-life, post-installation, cross-industry and closed loop waste streams.
- Timeless design that fits everywhere for everyone, the floor doesn't get outdated. The longer the floor can be used, the more circular it is.
- Net Fit installation lowering total footprint.

SOURCING & RAW MATERIALS

- Made out of up to 98% natural raw materials.
- All raw materials are obtained following the ethical and sustainable SA8000 and ISO 14001 certification.
- Naturally plastic-free and phthalate-free flooring.

PRODUCTION AND DISTRIBUTION

- Climate positive cradle to gate without offsetting based on EPD (Environmental Product Declaration) Marmoleum sheet also 3.2mm, 2026.
- 100% renewable electricity.

LONG-LASTING & EASY TO MAINTAIN

- Marmoleum is highly durable, the longer the floor can be used, the more circular it is. Sequestering carbon and creating no waste.
- The Topshield pro finish makes Marmoleum easy to clean, hard-wearing and resistant to stains.
- Marmoleum is fit for purpose, for many applications, no wax, no polish needed.

RECYCLING AND END-OF-LIFE

- We've closed the loop with Marmoleum Cocoa, the natural flooring solution that can be used over and over again.
- Of the total recycled content there is always 14% recycled pre-and/or post-consumer flooring waste.
- We've created a fully safe end-of-life recycling process with traceable uplifted Marmoleum flooring.

ADHESIVES & ACCESSORIES

Eurocol 616 - Eurostar lino green

Very low VOCs emissions, bio-based adhesive with high initial tack for bonding Marmoleum compact with jute backing. The use of lightweight fillers ensures low consumption and easy application. Certified with EMICODE EC 1PLUS, making it suitable for BREEAM projects. The use of renewable raw materials results in lower CO₂ emissions compared to standard fossil-based glue.



Eurocol 514

Fast-setting adhesive with high initial tack for bonding linoleum in sheets and tiles, on a levelled substrate. Good moisture resistance. Thanks to EMICODE EC 1PLUS (very low VOCs emissions) also suitable for BREEAM projects.



To weld or not to weld?

Marmoleum flooring does not shrink over time when properly installed. Therefore welding, in the majority of cases, is not required. Skilled installers can make perfect joints without using a welding rod.

Welding could be required or even prescribed in certain situations. There are many matching colours in our welding rods. A matching colour will blend in with the floor, a non-matching colour can be chosen for decorative reasons, for example to highlight different areas on the floor.
